

# A Seasonal Word from our Chairman

Dear Friends, it is that time of year again, when we pause to reflect and remember.

Our Group has continued with its aims to improve Awareness and provide Information, and has been able to offer Support in many ways. We have been instrumental in offering financial support to the Urooncology team at the Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital under Mr Edwin Ho, in enabling eight patients this year with serious recurrent Prostate Cancer to be given Cryo-Ablation therapy under this trial. With your help we have so far given £34,000 of the £50,000 needed to provide the support costs of the programme, which we hope will be completed in the New Year. Our hope is that following the encouraging results we have seen so far, we can persuade the NHS to introduce and fund this NICE approved treatment here as a permanent option, and become the only Hospital in the Eastern Region to offer it.

We have seen our membership grow to over 300, and attendance at our meetings has remained high. However, if the Group is to continue in its present form, be able to maintain this level of activity, and to improve our services, the Committee must have some more active members to join us. I urge those younger members, (men or women), who perhaps have just retired with some time to spare, and who want to help us make a difference, to consider joining us. We particularly need specific help from those with



experience in maintaining our website, and in editing our Newsletter. Dave Cole and Chuck Lyons have done sterling work on these tasks, but both now have increased commitments. Each is published bi-monthly, and details of what is involved can be given. In the words of our own Delia, "Lets be 'aving You!", (although it hasn't worked for Norwich City – perhaps we can do better).

Sadly, we have lost several more of our founders this year, and I also am now retiring as your Chairman, as anno domini takes its toll, but I hope to continue in supporting the Group other areas. I thank all those who take an active part in running the Group, our specialist nurses, the tea ladies, and all those beyond who support us.

Finally, on behalf of the Committee, our Best Wishes to you all for Christmas and the Coming Year.

# Big C gives Major Donation to NNUH Cryo-Ablation Trial

Big C announced on 30th November that they are joining us in funding the NNUH Cryo-Ablation Trial and are providing the remaining £12,000 to complete the trial in the form of a Grant. This is excellent news and will enable Mr Edwin Ho and his team to complete this vital project.

The next two patients with recurrent Prostate Cancer (Nos 7 & 8), will receive Cryo-Ablation treatment on Monday 3rd December.

NNUH recently announced that over £20m had been given to the Hospital this year by voluntary organisations and donors. This included £287,000 (now £299,000 with the above Big C donation) for Cancer treatment – of which our contribution of £34,000 has made a difference, along with the other Cancer Support Groups who have done the same – and a further £250,000 for Cancer equipment.
